
ATV/UTV Trail System For Frozen Ground Conditions

From December 1st to March 31st, you may operate your ATV/UTV on State-Funded Winter Use Trails on Burnett County Forest Lands once the ground is frozen and the Frozen Ground ATV Trail System has officially opened. Winter Use ATV Trails crossing land under other ownerships are closed until a 4" groomed snow base has been received. The Frozen Ground ATV Trail System shown here consists of a network of ATV/UTV trails located on Burnett County Forest Land and connecting segments of town road routes. All other trails are closed to ATV, UTV, ORV, and Motorcycle use. It is your responsibility to know whose land you are riding on.

 - Do not operate ATVs or UTVs on State or County highways or right-of-ways, unless marked as open to ATV/UTV use.
 - Township roads that are open have been approved by town boards; these approvals can be rescinded.
 - Trail use passes are required for ALL ATVs/UTVs not registered in Wisconsin. Ask DNR or ATV dealers to obtain them.
 - Only roads marked as ATV routes are authorized for ATV/UTV traffic. Obey all speed limits.
