2016-2017 ANNUAL TREE, SHRUB, AND PLANT SALE

Once again the Burnett County Land & Water Conservation Department, sponsored by the Natural Resources Committee, will be offering trees, shrubs, perennial plants and wildflower seed for sale to the general public.

All trees are measured from the root crown to the top of the tree. All trees are bare-root stock and have been in a seedbed a minimum of 2 years. Transplants have 2 additional years in a transplant bed. You may buy any number of bundled trees or shrubs you would like (by bundle quantity listed) and as many species as you prefer.

Trees are sold in bundles of 25; shrubs in bundles of 5; perennial plants by the tray and wildflower seed by the package/oz. There are no restrictions on what you can use your purchase for.

***Sales are first come, first serve (quantities are limited) – so order early.**

***We give the same guarantee as the nursery gives us: “We will give you healthy, disease-free stock but cannot guarantee growth due to factors beyond our control.”**

Payment in full (sales tax MUST be included) must be submitted WITH YOUR ORDER. *No CODs or credit cards will be accepted.

***All orders not picked up on the specified delivery date will be disposed of (stock is perishable) and no refund given.**

***Tentative delivery dates are end of April, 2017 for trees and shrubs; beginning of June, 2017 for perennials and wildflower seed.**

***If you are ordering for a shoreline restoration, please check your plan prior to ordering to ensure the item you order is compatible with your restoration plan.*

TREES—Our Renewable Resource



COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE

6-12" transplant. Slow growing, densely formed tree with stiff, silvery-blue to bluish-green needles. An excellent ornamental & background tree. Thrives in dry, well-drained soil. Height: 35 feet.



RED OAK

12-18" seedling. A wide, massive shade tree that provides acorns for a wide variety of wildlife. Grows on a variety of soils from medium sands to loams. Prefers full sun. Height: 80-90 feet. Growth rate: Moderate.



RED PINE

7-15" transplant. Rapid growing tree with 4-6" long, glossy-green needles. Many uses include timber, windbreak, & Christmas trees. Does well in sandy, dry soil. Prefers full sun. Height: 70-150 feet.



WHITE SPRUCE

9-14" seedling. Moderate growing tree with bluish-green needles & short, dense branches. A popular Christmas tree & windbreak. Endures drought conditions well. Does well in full sun. Height: 50-60 feet.



RED MAPLE

12-18" seedling. Medium to fast growth. Tolerates most soils with full to partial sun. Produces winged seeds in spring. Dull green leaves turn brilliant red, orange or yellow in fall. Height: 50-60 feet.



SILVER MAPLE

12-18" seedling. Very hardy, easy to grow tree; will tolerate a wide variety of soils. One of the best to grow where others may not survive. Grows to 60 feet.




WHITE PINE

6-12" seedling. Vigorous growing, open tree with long, soft bluish-green needles. Tolerates part shade. Grows well in sand & other soils. Ideal for windscreen. Height: 80 feet.



PIN CHERRY

12-18" seedling. Small & slender deciduous shrub/tree; bark is often shiny & reddish; sometimes takes on a somewhat "shrubby" appearance. Good for sandy soils. Fruit is good for wildlife. Can grow to 30' tall.



RED OSIER DOGWOOD

12-18" seedling. Grows best in moist to dry fertile soils. Full to partial sun. A broad erect grower: dark blood red branches; white flowers followed by white berries. Good for soil erosion, food & cover for wildlife. Grows 7-9 feet. Growth rate: fast.




JUNE BERRY

12-18" seedling. Colorful in all seasons. White flowers in spring; fall color is yellow, red or orange. Good for attracting birds. Tolerates a wide variety of soils. Full sun to part shade. Height: 8-15 feet. Growth rate: fast.



AMERICAN PLUM

12-18" seedling. A small tree or large shrub. White flowers in early May. Edible fruits—red or yellow. Very hardy & drought resistant. Grows well in most soil types unless very wet or dry. Excellent for wildlife plantings. Height: 15-20 feet. Growth rate: fast.



AMERICAN Highbush CRANBERRY

12-24" seedling. Attractive foliage turns red & orange in the fall. Flat clusters of white flowers followed by red berries. Grows to 8 ft.




NINE BARK

12-18" seedling. Maple-like leaves on mound-forming shrubs with closely spaced stems. Popular as a foundation planting shrub. Tough & easy. Moist to dry soils. Growth rate: fast. Height: 3-10 feet.



RED SPLENDOR CRAB APPLE

12-18" seedling. Red flower buds open into large deep pink single flowers. The fruit is dark & showy. Foliage is dark reddish green in the summer & turns a beautiful reddish purple in the fall. Upright spreading form. Growth rate: Moderate. Height: 15-25 feet.



Native Perennial PLANTS



COLLECTION #1 - DRY WILDFLOWERS/BUTTERFLY ATTRACTING

Habitat: Dry Prairie/Forest Edge Height: 12-36" Full-Part Sun 40-48 plants

Assortment picked from these Species: Anise Hyssop, Thimbleweed, Leadplant, Smooth Aster, Aster, Stiff Coreopsis, Heath Aster, Aromatic Aster, Prairie Coneflower, White Prairie Clover, Purple Prairie Clover, False Sunflower, Smooth Penstemon, Bergamot, Yellow Coneflower, Black-eyed Susan, Showy Goldenrod, Hoary Vervain, Golden Alexander, Royal Catchfly, Butterfly Weed, Lupine.

COLLECTION #2 - COMPLETE PRAIRIE WILDFLOWERS & GRASSES

Habitat: Dry Prairie Height: 12-36" Full-Part Sun 40-48 plants

Assortment picked from these Wildflower Species: Nodding Wild Onion, Purple Prairie Clover, White Prairie Clover, Stiff Coreopsis, Prairie Coneflower, Gaillardia, Smooth Aster, Pale Purple Coneflower, Purple Coneflower, Black-eyed Susan, Hoary Vervain, Lanceleaf Coreopsis, Royal Catchfly, Wild Quinine

Assortment picked from these Grass Species: Blue Grama, June Grass, Little Bluestem, Side Oats Grama, Canada Wild Rye, Indian Grass.

COLLECTION #3 - THE COMPLETE WETLAND/Shoreland Edge Mix

Habitat: Wet Prairie/Marsh/Lake Edge Height: 24-48" Full Sun-Part Shade 40-48 plants

Assortment picked from these Wildflower Species: New England Aster, Swamp Aster, Spotted Joe-Pye Weed, Cardinal Flower, Blue Lobelia, Boneset, Marsh Blazing Star, Grass Leaf Goldenrod, Sneezeweed, Flat Top Aster, Sweet Black Eyed Susan, Monkeyflower, Blue Vervain, Ironweed.

Assortment picked from these Grass Species: Bottlebrush Sedge, Porcupine Sedge, Caterpillar Sedge, Fox Sedge, Sweet Flag, Torrey's Rush, Path Rush, Soft Rush, Wool Grass.

COLLECTION #4 - WOODLAND MIX

Height: 6-36" 32-40 plants

Assortment picked from these Wildflower Species: Wild Columbine, Pearly Everlasting, Canada Anemone, Big Leaf Aster, Arrow-leaved Aster, Harebell, White Snakeroot, Woodland Strawberry, Jacob's Ladder, Zig Zag Goldenrod.

Assortment picked from these Grass Species: Pennsylvania Sedge, Long Beaked Sedge, Bottlebrush Grass.

Native Wildflower and Grass SEED

SEED MIX 1 - Dry/Butterfly Attracting Wildflower Mix (should cover 200 – 400 sq.ft.)

Appropriate habitat: Any open sunny area at least ½ day of sun with well-drained loam to sandy soil.

Assortment picked from these Species: Anise Hyssop; nodding wild onion; leadplant; wild aster; partridge pea; lance leaf coreopsis; showy tick-trefoil; pale coneflower; purple coneflower; rattlesnake master; common oxeye; bush clover; purple prairie clover; prairie coneflower; yellow coneflower; black-eyed Susan; goldenrod species; hoary vervain; liatris; possible others.

SEED MIX 2 – Complete Prairie (should cover 200 –400 sq.ft.)

Appropriate habitat: Any upland soil in part- (half day) to full sun.

Assortment picked from these Species: Mixed grasses – little bluestem; big bluestem; side oats grama grass; Canada wild rye; Indian grass; Wildflowers - anise hyssop; nodding wild onion; leadplant; wild aster; coreopsis; pale coneflower; purple coneflower; rattlesnake master; common oxeye; bush clover; blazing star; wild lupine; purple/white prairie clover; yellow coneflower; black-eyed Susan; goldenrod; hoary vervain; possibly others.

For the native plants and seeds, your order will contain an assortment chosen from the species listed, but will not contain *all* of the species listed. *Latin species names available upon request. Selections may vary depending on availability from the nursery.*
