Public Health Alert #4

Burnett County Public Health is alerting the public of potential COVID-19 exposure at the following Burnett County locations.

- Crow Bar, Webster, September 2-September 5, 2020
- Lilly Lake Tavern, Webster, September 2-September 5, 2020

If you were at this location during the provided dates AND are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, stay home, do not go to work and contact a healthcare provider to be tested. The potential exposure means that an individual or individuals that tested positive for COVID-19 were at the location on the dates/times given, and you may have been exposed.

Symptoms may develop 2-14 days after exposure, so please continue to monitor yourself. Symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or Runny nose
- Nausea or Vomiting
- Diarrhea
